Under the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation's Stormwater Permit, all construction site contractors and subcontractors must have at least one "trained individual" from their company on their construction sites on a daily basis that is responsible for implementation of Erosion Controls and Stormwater Management. **These individuals must have completed this 4 hour training class by May 1, 2010** on the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control and stormwater management.

This training covers both technical and regulatory aspects of stormwater management and erosion control, and is open to anyone including municipal officials, developers, contractors, non-profit organizations, and others.

4 hours of NYSDOS Continuing Education Credits are available for municipal officials (CEO's, Planning Board members and Zoning Board members) who attend this training.
