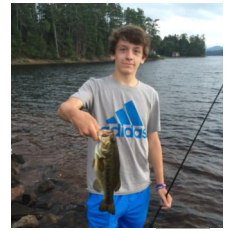

Stocking Rates: Trout = 400 per water surface acre, Bass = 100 per acre, Minnows = 750-1000 per acre.

Trout should be stocked every 2-3 years. Bass and Minnows once established, need not be restocked.

Trout Should Be Stocked in Cold Water Ponds = less than 72 degrees at surface in August.

Bass Should Be Stocked in Warm Water Ponds = greater than 72 degrees at surface in August.
